Transfers are not valid on route of issue. When boarding with a transfer, please present it to the driver unfolded and face up. Transfers can be reused until they expire.

Fare Information (contd)

Reduced Fare Identification

People who are disabled or over 65 years of age need a Reduced Fare Photo ID Card to ride the bus for \$0.50. The card must be shown each time you board the bus. Applications for the card are accepted only at The Bus Shop, second floor, The Plaza. Qualifications for a Reduced Fare Photo ID Card are:

- 1. Must be 65 years of age or older. Proof of age must be presented, or;
- 2. Qualifying disability application form to be completed by physician, or;
- 3. A valid Medicare card issued by the Social Security Administration.

How to Ride the Bus

1 Find your route number on this map. The map will show you where your route will travel, destination points and transferring locations to other routes.

2 Look for your bus stop. They are blue and will have the route number on them. Be sure the bus driver can see you when you are at the

Have your bus pass, token or cash fare ready. The farebox does not make change, nor does the bus driver. If your trip requires a transfer please ask the driver for one upon boarding.

When you are ready to get off the bus – press the yellow strip or pull the cord to signal to the driver you want to get off.

[5] If you need any additional help with your trip please do not hesitate to ask your driver. The driver will let you off at the next bus stop.

Rules of the Road

For the safety and comfort of all of our riders we ask the following....

No tobacco use.

No beverages in open containers.

No eating.

Shoes and shirts are required.

All animals must be kept in appropriate containers with absorbent materials in the carrier floor, except for service animals accompanying passengers who are disabled.

Radios, tapes or CD players must be played through earphones.

Non-collapsible strollers, baby buggies and carts block the aisle and therefore must be prohibited. Collapse strollers or carts before boarding the bus.

No gasoline and flammable liquids are allowed on the bus.

No explosives or corrosives are allowed.

Religious, sales? commercial? or political literature may not be distributed on the bus.

No firearm or weapons of any type are allowed on the bus.

Bicycles are allowed only on the front of the bus on the racks.
